Toms Deutschseite is a personal website created to teach his foreign wife German. The focus is on grammar and basic vocabulary. Students can choose any topic and find links to downloadable PDFs under the "Exercises" section. Mein-Deutschbuch.de offers free online exercises in PDF format for training grammar skills. However, since all instructions are only in German, these worksheets are suitable for intermediate and advanced students who can understand written German. Additionally, there's a language course called "Learn German with Stories" that contains ten stories narrated by Dino, a young man from Sicily learning German. The stories are suitable for beginners and include questions to answer at the end of each episode. Marktplatz is a business German course developed by Deutsche Welle, but it has been temporarily removed due to website issues. It includes 26 chapters that address specific business topics and can be downloaded as separate PDF files. Students with a B2 level or higher may want to try reading "real" German books. The website provides a list of resources for downloading German eBooks in PDF format. The Goethe-Zertifikat A1 Start Deutsch 1 offers various free resources for language learners to prepare for their exams. Tele provides downloadable mock exams in PDF format, which include answer keys, to help students assess their preparation level. The Goethe Institute also offers a list of its exams with clickable links, where users can find practice materials, sample tests, and audio files that are available for free download.
