Captain Holly Short is a character in the Artemis Fowl novel series by Eoin Colfer. Character outlineHolly Short is an unusual and quirky elf with an auburn crew cut (although she later grows a fringe) and 1 hazel and 1 blue eye, as well as the pointy ears typical of her species and nut-brown skin of a coffee complexion. She got her name because she is extremely short as she stands at one meter in height (said to be three feet in US editions), one centimeter shorter than the fairy average (an inch shorter in US editions), and has a gymnast-like stance. Like all elves, she is child-sized by human standards, but her bodily proportions are adult. According to Artemis Fowl and the Arctic Incident, Holly is about eighty years old (Elves and other magic species live much longer than humans). It is said that there is a dwarf over 2000 years old in the book). Holly is the first and only female captain in the organization LEPPrecon. In The Artemis Fowl Files, she notes that she eventually earns the respect of her male colleagues. Holly will defy the orders of superiors and disobey rules if she believes that she can be of more help that way, and has gotten into trouble multiple times for defying a direct command. She is described as pretty, but in a dangerous way, comparable to a black widow. Her interests include playing the fairy game "Crunchball", reading (especially thrillers), and flying with artificial wings. Holly lost her father at a young age. Her mother, Coral Short, is described as a European elf who was temperamental and had an appearance similar to Holly's. Artemis Fowl and the Time Paradox reveals that her mother worked in Lower Elements Police division "LEFmarine" and died after she was exposed to radiation, which is poisonous to fairies. After Artemis Fowl and the Opal Deception, Holly suits the LEP because the new LEP commander Ark Sool mentions that he will keep close to her to catch any fairies and she begins to work with Mulch Diggums. However, after working as a private detective with Mulch for a short time, she returns to the Section 8 unit of the LEP in Artemis Fowl and the Lost Colony, in time to get Artemis, Butler and the others out of trouble. Her relationship with Artemis Fowl has changed dramatically since the beginning of the series, morphing from hostility to grudging respect to friendship, and has recently included substantial hints of a romantic attraction despite the species and age gap (the mental and chronological age gaps being closed in Artemis Fowl and the Lost Colony and physical age gap briefly being closed for Artemis Fowl and the Time Paradox, both via extensive time travel).AppearanceIn Artemis FowlIn Artemis Fowl, Holly is abducted by 12-year-old criminal mastermind Artemis Fowl II when he uncovers evidence of fairy existence. He demands one metric ton of gold as her ransom fund. When she consents to granting Artemis's wish of restoring his mother's sanity, he releases her along with half of her ransom fund. Holly also then realizes that she is up for a challenge, and promises to be waiting for him, with "a big gun and a smile." In The Eternity CodeIn Artemis Fowl and the Eternity Code, Artemis requests Holly's help to heal Domovoi Butler after he nearly died and retrieve his C Cube from American businessman Jon Spiro. Together with Mulch Diggums, Juliet Butler, and Foaly directing technological elements of the mission, they break into the Spiro Needle and retrieve the Cube. Artemis is mind wiped at the end of the mission under the directions of Julius Root.In The Opal DeceptionIn Artemis Fowl and the Opal Deception, Holly is with Commander Root, a paternal figure to her, when Opal Koboi kills him. She is subsequently framed for the Commander's death and is forced to flee from fairy authorities. She later collaborates with Artemis Fowl, Butler, and Mulch Diggums to expose Koboi and prevent her plans for destroying fairy civilization. Koboi is locked up in a secure facility. At the end of the book, Holly resigns from the LEP.In The Lost ColonyIn Artemis Fowl and the Lost Colony, Holly is working as a private detective since her resignation from the LEP, along with Mulch Diggums. Though it was not going well and now they are bounty hunters, which are considered even less trustworthy than criminals they track. Holly is informed about the demon race, a species of fairy that left earth and are now inhabiting an island in Limbo between earth and time, and recruited to Section Eight, which monitors them. When it becomes apparent that Artemis has encountered a demon, they encounter Minerva Paradizo, another child genius who has managed to obtain a demon, and the deranged Billy Kong. Artemis and Holly, along with two demons, 1 and Qwan, are forced to go to Hybras to save demon civilization. When they arrive back at Artemis and Holly's time, they find that three years have passed in their own dimension.In The Time ParadoxIn Artemis Fowl and the Time Paradox, Artemis and Holly travel into the past to find the silky sifaka lemur, the only thing that can save Angeline Fowl from death by a fairy disease, Spelltrophy. The pair are forced to outwit Artemis's younger self and Damon Kronski, president of the "Extinctionists" organization. They eventually encounter Opal Koboi, who needs the silky sifaka lemur to increase her own power. In the novel, Holly kisses Artemis, likes it, and quickly attributes it to the effects of time travel as she is now an adolescent fairy.In The Atlantis ComplexIn Artemis Fowl and the Atlantis Complex, Artemis is mentally ill; his dabbles with magic have resulted in his developing Atlantis Complex; a fairy disease equivalent to OCD and multiple-personality disorder. Atlantis Complex also gives the victim a large amount of paranoia. He arranges for Holly and her fairy companions to meet him at a glacier in Iceland. Later, however, when Artemis proceeds to demonstrate his invention- a means of curing global warming- orions, a hacked martian probe goes rogue descends and attacks the LEP ship on the glacier, killing several marines and Commander Raine Vinyava, then heads towards Atlantis, the underwater fairy metropolis. Entangled in a conspiracy planned by Holly's old nemesis, the impending crisis and Artemis's rapid deterioration into a sopply alter-ego called Orion who perceives Holly as his 'fair princess' forces Holly to take the lead and find a way to bring back Artemis before it is too late.In The Last GuardianIn Artemis Fowl and the Last Guardian, Artemis' condition has improved, with he and Holly having formed a certain friendship and finally starting out in LEP traffic. Her parents are proud of her, and she is happy to be home. Holly notes her father died when she was barely sixty, which was nearly twenty years ago. Something in her life, she says she was bitten in the behind by a Swear, which is a demon. Holly is unable to complete their mission due to a Goblin Hit Squad sent by Cudgeon. Artemis and Holly then logically conclude that if Goblins were sent above ground to kill the head of the LEP, Root, then they are also after the body, which means rebellion. Holly confirms his suspicions by sending a text message to Artemis's phone. While trying to get on a train full of radioactive waste to get away from the goblin hit squad, Holly loses her finger. Without a drop of magic left, Holly needs to complete the ritual. They then foil Cudgeon and Koboi by breaking into Koboi Labs with the help of convict dwarf Mulch Diggums.The Eternity Code Holly In The Eternity Code, Holly helps Artemis recover the C Cube from Jon Spiro. She is only convinced to help him after seeing how Butler almost died as a result of Jon Spiro's goons. She had developed a respect for Butler, and so decides to put her best effort to heal him with her magic, which revives him, but uses up some of his life energy and causes some unforeseen complications, such as the fusion of some Kevlar with his chest. Artemis is eternally grateful, but additionally asks her to help get the C Cube back as its ability to track fairy communication and intelligence would put The People at possible risk of being discovered. She saves Artemis from imprisonment at the hands of Spiro as a part of the plan. She initially is opposed to Artemis's step in the plan where she is to remove and then re-attach Spiro's finger to gain access to the safe. After the plan starts to go wrong, she maintains following Artemis's lead while helping him devise solutions. She foils Spiro by making Artemis invisible by shielding. The LEP then mind-wipes Artemis, Butler, and Juliet, despite her resistance to the idea, as she worried erasing Artemis's memories would cause him to regress into criminal behavior, undoing all the moral development he has gained. In the Opal DeceptionOne year later, in the Opal Deception, Holly witnesses the death of Commander Root, for which she has been blamed. Holly then goes to the Kronski hotel to try and save Artemis and Butler from a Bio Bomb, which was meant to kill them. However, Artemis cannot remember her, though he tries to help Holly stop Opal's plan nonetheless. The two are taken to the replica Temple of Artemis in the Eleven Wonders Exhibition, where they are nearly killed by trolls. In this latest near-death scenario, she proclaims that her and Artemis can finally be considered friends. Artemis remembers all of the past year's adventures, thanks to the computer disk that he gave to Mulch Diggums, disguised as the coin Holly has given him. Together with Artemis, Butler, and Mulch, they then foil Koboi's plot and save Haven City. In the end she quits the LEP because of the replacement for Root.The Lost ColonyIn The Lost Colony, readers discover that Holly and Artemis have been working together on cases that Holly takes for her private eye job with Mulch. She later gets recruited by Commander Vinyava for Section 8 and is sent to ask Artemis why he made contact with a demon and Foaly was off by ten feet. She maintains her presence throughout the novel until she is sent by Artemis to rescue N1. From that moment on she "sits in the driver's seat" switching between Artemis and other characters on occasion. After rescuing N1, Holly, Artemis, and Qwan (a demon warlock) take to the skies with a bomb strapped to Holly's wrist. The plan was to fly to a safe location and dismantle the bomb. Only her suit can't take the weight so they fall from a great height. Artemis uses his wits to enact a plan that sends everyone connected to Holly to Hybras. There Holly dies begging Artemis to help her. Artemis takes one glimpse of her and walks away, as he has to dedicate his full focus to blast a shot into a portal to the past to prevent her death from happening in the first place. He saves Holly, Qwan, and N*1 by reversing time after Abbot, the traitor demon, kills them. Eventually, Artemis transports everyone on Hybras (including a living Holly) to a future three years from the time they left. Holly rejoins the LEP because Trouble Kelp becomes commander. The end for another saves the secret society adventure. The Time ParadoxIn The Time Paradox, Holly teams up with Artemis once again when Artemis manipulates her into helping him, by blaming her for infecting Angeline Fowl with Spelltrophy, a debilitating disease that decimated nearly 25 percent of the fairy race. Holly and Artemis then proceeded to travel back in time to rescue the last silky sifaka lemur, whose brain fluid is the cure for Spelltrophy. Holly exited the time tunnel as a teenager and Artemis grew older. She is also reverted to an adolescent emotional state. While trying to rescue the lemur from Artemis' younger self, Artemis is mortally wounded. She heals him and then kisses him. However, when he lies to her about giving his mother Spelltrophy, she is appalled and becomes icy towards him. Later, when he tries to make it up to her by letting her say goodbye to a (younger) Julius Root, Holly became unsure of herself; she tells him that he is forgiven, but adds that his 'elf-kissing days are over'. At the end of the book, the atmosphere between them seems uncertain. She heals Artemis from the Kraken explosion and has conflicting feelings as she carries the unconscious boy back to Fowl Manor. She uses her wings to rise to eye level with him, paused, kissed him on the cheek and says: "In another time," and then left.The Atlantis ComplexIn The Atlantis Complex, Holly was one of the four fairies invited by Artemis to attend his presentation of the Ice Cube. She later concluded that Artemis is suffering from Atlantis Complex, then witnessed the homicide of Wing Commander Vinyava along with fourteen LEP officers by the rogue probe Turnbull Root cannibalised as part of his bid for freedom. Eventually, Holly saved a then delirious Artemis from being crushed by the descending probe, reverting Artemis' alternate personality,Orion, into control in the process, and used his Ice Cube to fend off the murderous Amorphobots while Artemis lay unconscious from her Neutrinoblast. When the Martian probe dives down beneath the ice sheets, Holly, with Foaly and Orion in tow, pilots a service pod after it, only to find it aiming to crack Atlantis's Dome. She was forced to knock out her passengers and falling unconscious herself while struggling to send word to Haven due to a leak in the oxygen tank.Upon breaching the water surface, Artemis was back in control and the trio received contact from Commander Trouble Kelp. They were later rescued by Mulch Diggums and the Butler siblings, before falling hostage to Turnbull Root while tailing him and his Amorphobots. Holly was then branded with a thrall rune and sent to detain N1 to grant Leonor Carsby her youth. Orion later incapacitated her and witnessed Turnbull and Leonor's deaths.Holly was last seen remaining by Artemis's bedside inside the Nostremius hospital ship, back in control of herself. She caringly consoles a guilt-ridden and miserable Artemis, assuring him of the J. Argon clinic's credibility and promising to keep him company during his rehabilitation. She comforts him by saying that despite all the tragedy that has occurred as a result of this incident, that he has shown great growth in his motivations now being about protecting others and the Earth as a whole. She assures him that she and his other friends will be there with him through his recovery process. She lastly stated she would leave soon to put a stop to Juliet's wrestling match with a jumbo pixie.The Last GuardianIn the final book, Holly develops a fascination with the clone of Opal, cruelly nicknamed "Nopal". Artemis discovers her staring at the clone shortly after he is released from the J. Argon clinic. They are then called to Internal Affairs to witness the younger Opal being held hostage by pixies. Holly flies them to Fowl Manor and plays a large role in the Battle of Fowl Manor, taking out a large number of Berserkers. When Holly discovers Artemis plan to sacrifice himself to save the lives of his friends, family, and humanity as a whole, she tries to prevent him by sedating him, to then take his place. Artemis is forced to sedate her in order to complete the final step of his plan to defeat Opal and close the Berserker Gate. Beforehes passes outfrom the drug, Artemis kisses her forehead, thanking her for "fixing" him, telling her he was a "broken boy", and leaves.He is killed shortly after, but not before Holly sees him helpless in the force of the closing of the Gate. Holly then brings Artemis's DNA and they make a clone. His spirit comes and inhabits the clone, therefore essentially bringing himself back to life. He does not yet remember anything, and so Holly is last seen walking with the newly resurrected Artemis back to Fowl Manor, telling him the story of his life.The Fowl TwinsAt the end of The Fowl Twins, it is revealed that Holly has been promoted to Commodore in the LEP, and has a number of shuttles under her command. She also has a hand in the training of new LEP cadets. Lazuli Heitz refers to Holly as her "angel mentor", and was trained, at least in part, by Holly. Holly is additionally surprised to see NANNI, designed after her brainwaves and Artemis', to be operating under her voice and image.QuotesArtemis Fowl"So what is this master plan, Fowl?
